

Return to School

Dear Parents / Carers,

The wait is nearly over! Teachers are currently in school making the final preparations before we welcome our children back to Willow Green tomorrow. Before then I just wanted to provide a couple of key messages.

Arrival / Departure

As stated in my previous letter, it is really important that children arrive promptly for the start of their school day. Children in Y1, Y3 and Y5 will start at 8.30am and EYFS (Nursery and Reception), Y2, Y4 and Y6 will start at 8.45am. Tomorrow's afternoon Nursery session will be 12.15pm - 1.15pm. It is important that we limit the amount of parents on site at any one time so if you could arrive just before this time, drop your child off with their teacher on the playground and then follow the one way system off the school grounds this will help us greatly.

Please could all parents and carers ensure that safe social distancing is maintained whilst on the school grounds.

Packed lunches - Nuts

As an addition to the information I sent regarding packed lunches please could we ask that, as in the past, children do not bring nuts or nut products into school. We have a number of children with allergies.

PPE

As part of our control measures, around the corridors in school, staff and visitors will be wearing face coverings in the form of see through visors – very much like the ones you and the children will have seen used in supermarkets and shops. It is a good idea to let the children know to expect this. These coverings will not be routinely worn in classrooms by teachers in their own bubbles so the amount of interaction that children have with staff in visors will be limited.
