

KS1 Nativity

Dear Parents / Carers,

As a school, this year we are keen to make sure that the children have a memorable Christmas experience and we believe that the KS1 nativity plays a huge part in this.

We have carefully considered recent local authority and national guidance, and have decided that the KS1 performance this year can go ahead as planned on the **13th December**.

As you would expect, we have carried out a thorough risk assessment and we will be implementing control measures to ensure that this event is as safe as possible for pupils, parents and staff.

Control measures:

- Admission by **ticket only**.
- A maximum of **2 tickets per family** and these will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.
- Family pairs must sit together and attend the **same performance**. Seats will be spaced in the hall to aid distancing and minimise crossing of family bubbles.
- Face coverings must be worn throughout the performance (unless proof of exemption is provided).
- Entry to the hall will be from the external door – there will be no access into the school (eg no use of the toilets)
- Hand sanitiser will be supplied on entry.
- **We ask that all parents and staff carry out a LFD test on the morning of the event.**
- We ask that people **should not attend** if they have **any symptoms** of COVID.

There will be two performances on the day **9.15am** and **2.15pm** and is open to the families of **Y1 and Y2** families. Due to capacity restrictions, each family will only be allocated tickets to attend only **one of these performances**.
