Independence

Through our open ended play environment children will develop confidence and autonomy to choose their own experiences based on their own likes and dislikes.

Achievement

Through our systematic phonics scheme children will gain the first fundamental skills in their journey to read and write.

Pride

Children will develop a connection to their key group and have sense of pride in belonging to a group naming and recognising it as theirs when called upon.

Responsibility

Children will develop a sense of responsibility for making good choices when choosing snack and explain why we need to have a healthier lifestyle.

Children will understand and identify our expectations and follow them, sharing these with others when needed.
