At home we would like you to engage with dojo and learn the signs. You can also have a go at reading traditional tales to support the use of vocabulary.

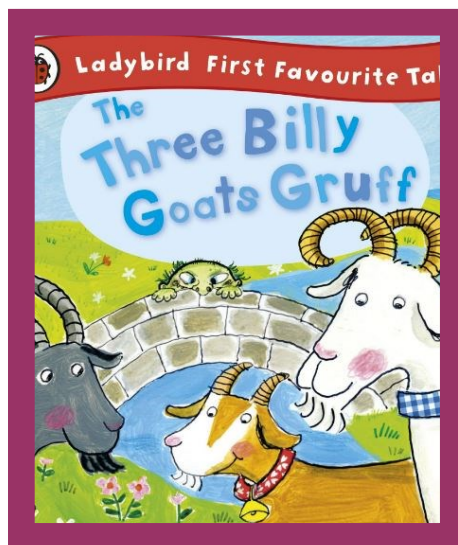

Mathematics

EAD

We are looking at using our observational skills to manipulate salt dough to create animals. We will use some dried pasta, beans and marks to add the detail.

At home you can make salt dough and create your own animals, bugs or fish.

UTW

We are focusing on environments for animals and where they live. We are looking at growing our own and exploring celebrations such as EID. We are exploring the different buttons on a beebot and will use iPads to find out information by scanning QR codes.

At home can you look at growing something in your garden or kitchen window. Could you see what it needs each day and how to take care of it.

PD...

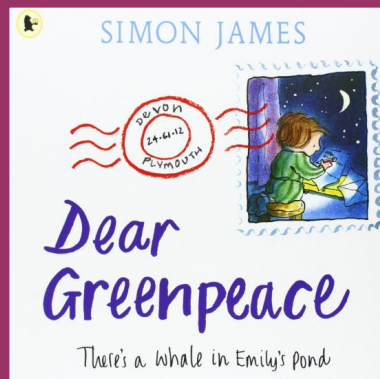
In PE we will focus on ball skills and carrying out instructions. We will move our bodies fast and slow, up and down.
