



Summer Overview – Year 1

Reading	Writing	Maths	Curriculum
<p>This term, in phonics we will be learning our set 3 sounds. We will start with split digraphs and build up until we have learnt all our sounds. We will then apply these to read our Read, Write Inc story books.</p> <p>Alongside this, we will be reading our new Super Six story books!</p> 	<p>Fiction We are using our model text 'The Queen's Hat' as we learn about journey stories. Within this unit, the children will learn a range of techniques to build action within their writing.</p> <p>Non-Fiction We will be exploring non-chronological reports. We are using the model text about Queen Elizabeth to write our own reports about King Charles.</p>	<p>Measurement We will be learning how to measure at first with non-standard units and then with a ruler.</p> <p>Multiplication and Division We will begin learning about how to solve multiplication and division questions and simple word problems.</p> <p>Fractions This half term, we will be learning about halves and quarters. We will find halves and quarters of shapes and numbers.</p> <p>Position and Direction In this unit, we learn to use the vocabulary left, right, forwards, backwards, above and below and will practise using our ordinal numbers.</p>	<p>Within our Reading Enhanced Curriculum (REC) we will be using the book 'We Are Going On Safari' to enhance our knowledge within our curriculum session.</p>  <p>Geography</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What are the different continents? - What does an area look like? - Where in the world is Tanzania? - What animals are found in Tanzania? - How is Tanzania different from where I live? <p>This unit will include a trip to Tropical World to investigate the animals of Tanzania and their habitats.</p> <p>Art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is sculpture? - Who is Richard Shilling? - What materials can I use to make a sculpture? - How can I make a sculpture? <p>Science-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How do plants grow in our environment? <p>Following our investigation of seasons, plants and trees last half term, we will be growing our own plants and watching how the trees change from spring to summer.</p>
