




Summer Overview – Year 5

<p>In reading, we are looking at the story 'Who Let the Gods Out'</p>  <p>During our reading session, we will be focusing on building their fluency skills, and ability to answer a range of comprehension questions.</p> <p>Our whole class end of day text is 'There's a boy in the girls' bathroom'.</p>  <p>This book is read to the class at the end of the day to build on their love of reading.</p>	<p>Fiction: We are using our model text 'The Nightmare Man' as we learn about tales of fear. Within this unit, the children will learn a range of techniques to build suspense within their writing.</p> <p>Non-Fiction: We will be exploring discussion. We are using the model text 'Should we be afraid of the dark?' We will be looking at the structure of the text type and will apply our knowledge learnt to write our own piece linking to our History unit.</p>	<p>Perimeter and Area</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes, and polygons. - Area of rectangles and compound shapes. - Estimating Area. <p>Statistics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Draw, read, and interpret line graphs. - Read and interpret tables, including two-way tables. - Read and interpret timetables. <p>Shape</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand and use degrees. - Classify and estimate angles. - Draw and calculate angles. - Understand 3-D shapes. <p>Position and Direction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read and plot coordinates. - Understand translation with coordinates. - Identify lines of symmetry. 	<p>Within our Reading Enhanced Curriculum (REC) we will be using the book 'Politics for Beginners' to enhance our knowledge within our curriculum session.</p>  <p>History</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is democracy? - When was the first English King? - How did William rule differently to Egbert? - Did Henry VIII use corruption to gain power? - How reliable is our knowledge of the gunpowder plot? <p>Art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is architecture? - How do ink and graphite create accurate lines? <p>Science-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How can we compare materials?
