



Summer Overview – Year 1

Reading	Writing	Maths	Curriculum
<p>This term, in phonics after the success of our phonics screening assessments, we will be securing our set 3 sounds and learning to read longer words. We will then focus on applying our knowledge to read our books with fluency and expression.</p> <p>Alongside this, we will be reading our new Super Six story books!</p> 	<p>Fiction We are using our model text 'Grandad's Island' as we learn about portal stories. Within this unit, the children will learn a range of techniques to build description within their writing.</p> <p>Non-Fiction We will be exploring persuasive texts. We are using a travel brochure as our model text and will design our own holiday islands and write a text to persuade people to visit the island.</p>	<p>Place Value We will be learning how to partition numbers up to 100 and then compare and order numbers by looking at how many tens and how many ones they have.</p> <p>Money We will begin by learning to recognise coins and will then use out counting skills to count how much money in a group of coins.</p> <p>Try this game at home to help the children practise their money skills.</p> <p>Coins Game for 4-10 year olds (topmarks.co.uk)</p> <p>Time This half term, we will be learning to tell the time. We will learn about the hands of a clock and then to tell the time when it is o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.</p>	<p>Within our Reading Enhanced Curriculum (REC) we will be using the book 'Lila and the Secret of the Rain' to enhance our knowledge within our curriculum session.</p>  <p>Geography</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is the weather like in Kenya? - What trees grow in Kenya? - What is drought? - What is a flood? - Why are wells so important in Kenya? - Water – Why is it so important to Kenya? <p>Art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is a silhouette? - How can I use soft pastels to draw? - How can I trace to create an outline? - How can I combine soft pastels to make a sunset scene? <p>Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What does waterproof mean? - What is a Macintosh? - How can we compare how waterproof a material is?
