


Summer 2 Overview – Year 3

<p>In reading, we are looking at the story 'The Firework-Makers Daughter'. A thrilling adventure about a young girl called Lila. Every Firework-Maker must make a perilous journey to face the terrifying Fire-Fiend! Can Lila possibly survive? Children will continue to develop skills in reading comprehension with focus on vocabulary, retrieval and inference & deduction skills.</p> 	<p>Fiction: We are using our model text 'Midas' as we learn about stories with characters who have a character flaw. Within this unit, the children will learn a range of techniques to build action into their writing.</p> <p>Non-Fiction: We will be exploring persuasion.
