








Summer 2 Overview – Year 5

Reading	Writing	Maths	Curriculum
<p>In reading, we are looking at the story 'Who Let the Gods Out'.</p>  <p>During our reading session, we will be focusing on building their fluency skills, and ability to answer a range of comprehension questions.</p> <p>Our whole class end of day text is 'Friend or Foe by Michael Morpurgo.</p>  <p>This book is read to the class at the end of the day to build on their love of reading.</p>	<p><u>Fiction writing</u></p> <p>We are using our model text 'Princess of Fire' as we learn about stories with a character flaw.</p> <p>Within this unit, the children will learn a range of techniques to build dialogue within their writing. They will be learning how to accurately punctuate dialogue, as well as reference the speaker and add actions to their speech.</p> 	<p><u>Decimals</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Add and subtract decimals within 1. - Add and subtract decimals across 1. - Decimal sequences. - Multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000. <p><u>Negative numbers</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand negative numbers. - Count through zero. - Compare and order negative numbers. - Find the difference. <p><u>Converting units</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Kilograms and kilometres. - Millimetres and millilitres. - Convert units of length - Convert between metric and imperial units. - Convert units of time. - Calculate timetables. <p><u>Volume</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cubic centimetres - Compare and estimate volume. - Estimate capacity. 	<p>Within our Reading Enhanced Curriculum (REC) we will be using the book 'Politics for Beginners' to enhance our knowledge within our curriculum session.</p>  <p>History</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Was the English Civil War an example of democracy? - Who were the Suffragettes? - How do different leaders bring about change? - What legacy did the Suffragettes leave? - How has politics affected who we are today? <p>Art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is abstract art? - How can I alter colour using acrylic paint? - How can I create texture using acrylic paint? - How can I create abstract art? <p>Science-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What are reversible changes? - What is dissolving? - How do we separate mixtures?
